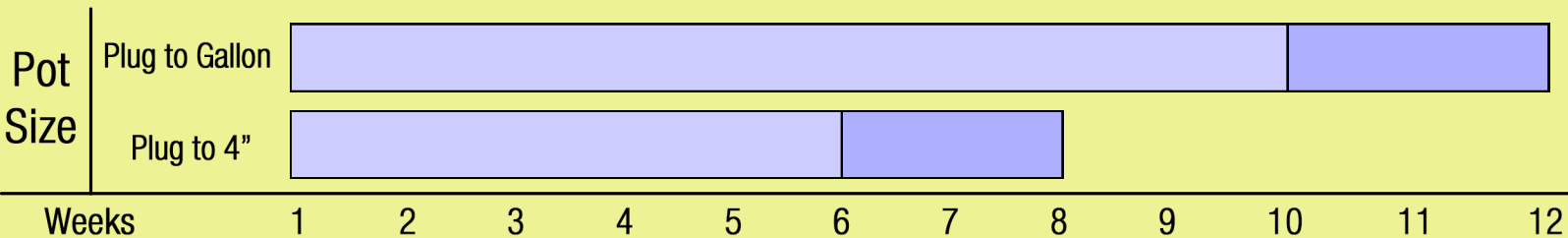


Growing Recipe

AGASTACHE 'PEACH PEARL'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

□ = Minimum □ = Maximum



pH: 5.8 - 6.2

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 2.0 - 3.0

Light Levels: Full sun

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 6 - 10

Possible Problems: Insect: Spider mites and white fly are possible

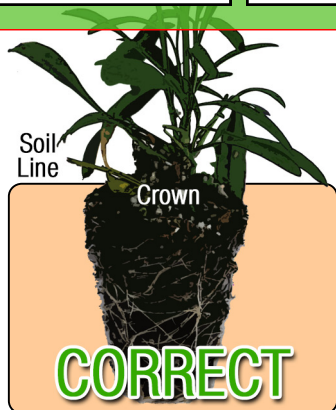
Habit: Upright

Diseases: None seen. Naturally resistant to downy mildew.

Day Length for Flowering: Long day
