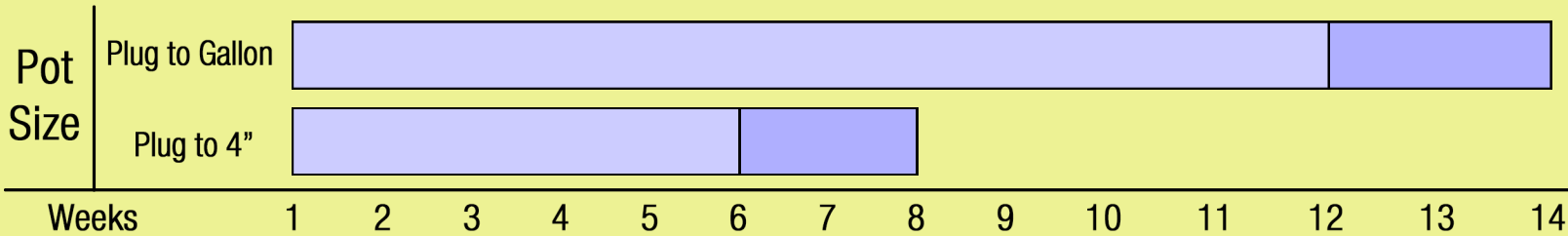


# Growing Recipe

# ECHINACEA NOVA® 'CAYENNE'

## Approximate Finish Time From Liner

□ = Minimum □ = Maximum



pH: 5.8 - 7.3

Fertilization Recommendations: 75 - 100 PPM

EC: 0.7

Light Levels: Full sun

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

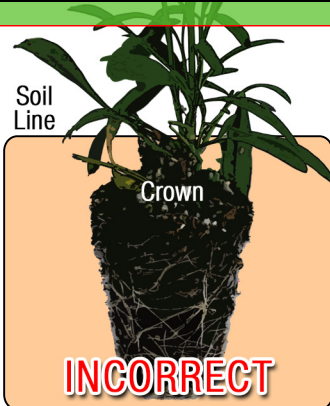
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Watch for aphids, mites, thrips, whitefly and slugs

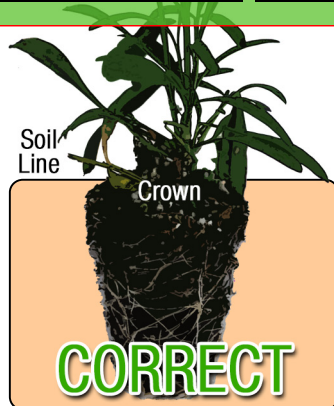
Habit: Clumping, upright

Diseases: The plants can have leaf spot and crown rot if kept too moist

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

## Description

Spicy, chili-red flowers cover this nearly perfectly round plant. Mid-sized, double flowers are well spaced all around, giving this plant great coverage and use as both a garden plant and marvelous container specimen. Unusual blue-green dense foliage color provides a great contrast to the fiery colored flowers. Perfect mid-size Echinacea for the garden.
