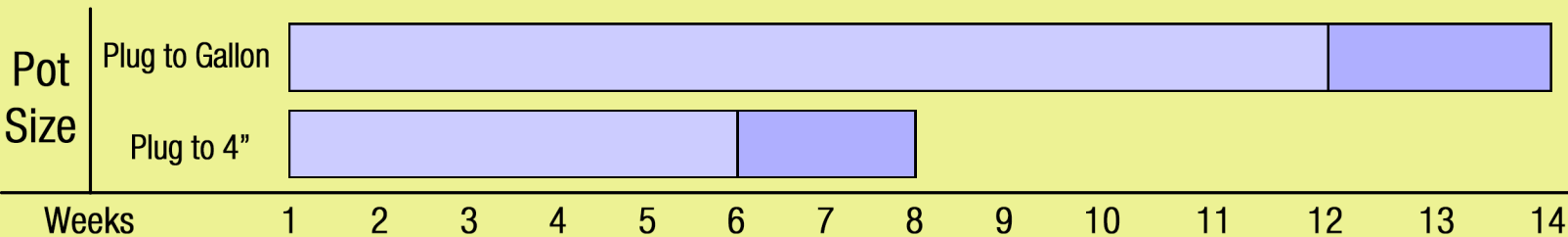


Growing Recipe

ECHINACEA NOVA® 'PINA COLADA'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

☐ = Minimum ☐ = Maximum



pH: 5.8 - 7.3

Fertilization Recommendations: 75 - 100 PPM

EC: 0.7

Light Levels: Full sun

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Watch for aphids, mites, thrips, whitefly and slugs

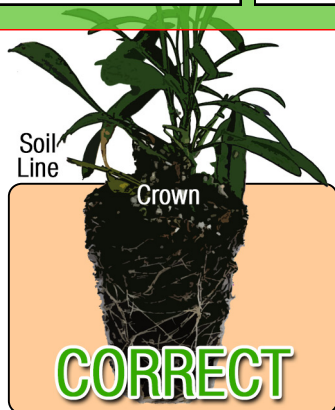
Habit: Clumping, upright

Diseases: The plants can have leaf spot and crown rot if kept too moist

Day Length for Flowering: Long day



Do NOT bury the crown of the plug



Description

Smooth, double, tri-toned flowers are held quite upright on a small to mid-sized plant. Flowers emerge as a yellow, green-eyed daisy and progress to lemon yellow then to coconut cream in its full double stage. Tight, compact habit lends itself to smaller garden and mixed containers. 'Pina Colada' is charming and garden worthy; ear worm unintentional.
