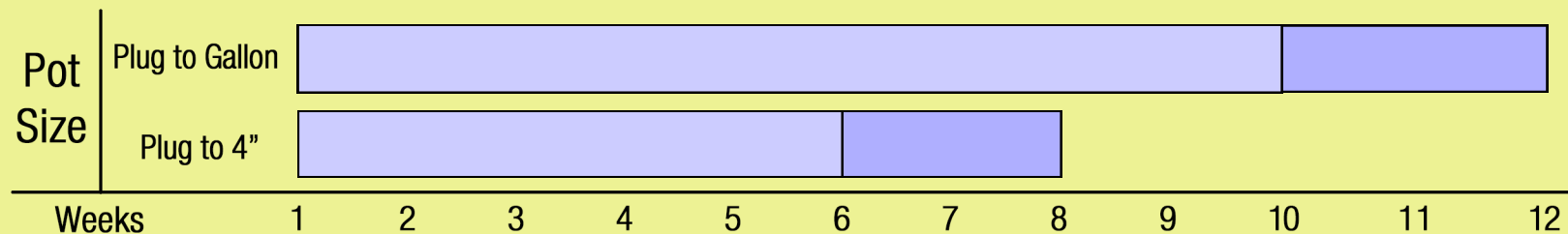


Growing Recipe

HEUCHERA 'IRIDESCENT'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

☐ = Minimum ☐ = Maximum



pH: 5.8 - 6.2

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 1.5 - 2.5

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry slightly between waterings

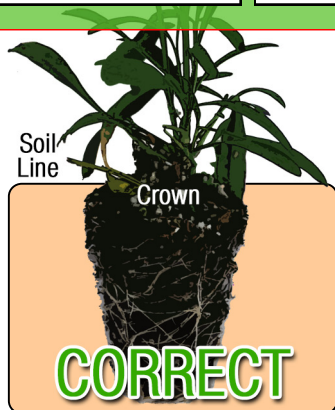
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas. Watch for root weevils.

Habit: Clumping

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture. Powdery mildew, rust, and leaf spots may occur.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

An absolute new color in Heuchera! Pearly lavender and rose colored leaves are held in a tight mound. Both a blender and standout, 'Iridescent' lives up to its name. Light pink flowers compliment the soft colors in the leaves. Very sun tolerant. Vigorous, too.
