

# HEUCHERA 'SEA GLASS'

## Approximate Finish Time From Liner

☐ = Minimum    ☐ = Maximum



pH: 5.8 - 6.2

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 1.5 - 2.5

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry slightly between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas. Watch for root weevils.


Habit: Clumping

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture. Powdery mildew, rust, and leaf spots may occur.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Heuchera 'Sea Glass' brings a breath of coastal calm to the garden with its minty-lime foliage that glows like sunlit sea glass. The rounded, scalloped leaves form a tidy mound, offering a crisp contrast to darker companions. In summer, slender stems rise with delicate white blooms, adding a soft shimmer to the scene.
