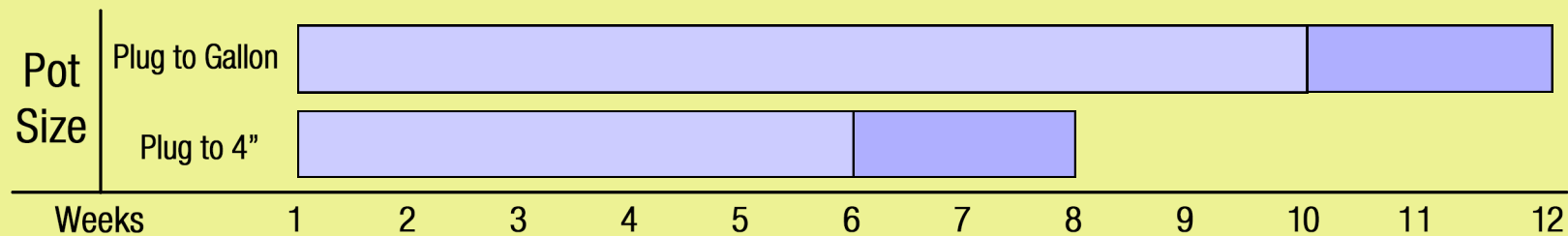


Growing Recipe

HEUCHERA 'TESTAROSSA'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

□ = Minimum □ = Maximum



pH: 5.8 - 6.2

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 1.5 - 2.5

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

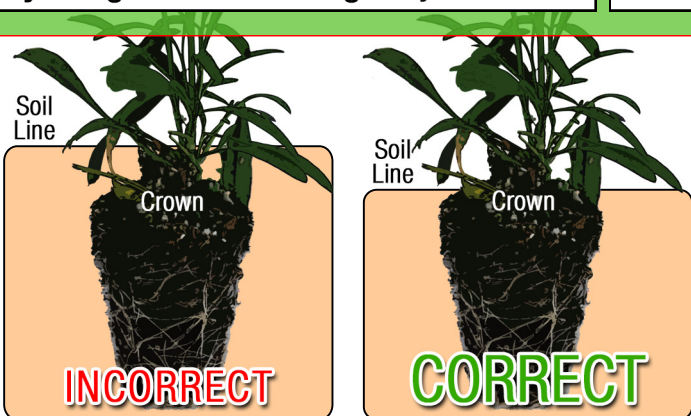
Possible Problems: Insect: Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas. Watch for root weevils.
Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture. Powdery mildew, rust, and leaf spots may occur.

Habit: Clumping

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Description

Testarossa is Italian for red head, and indeed, this red head is fabulous! Large red-red leaves on this medium-large plant. Trialed for multiple year for performance and hardiness, we couldn't take our eyes off of it. Superb fall color too! Stout plant with short petioles gives this plant a taller, mounding look without any steminess.
