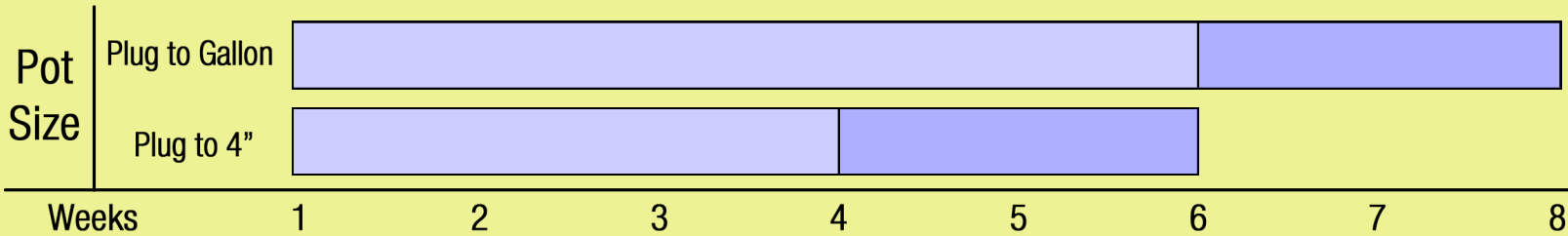


Growing Recipe

PHYGELIUS 'LEMON SPRITZER'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

pH: 6.1 - 7.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM

EC: 0.75 - 1.5

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 7 - 10

Possible Problems: Insect: No major

Diseases: No major

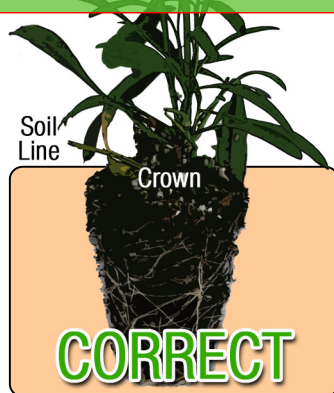
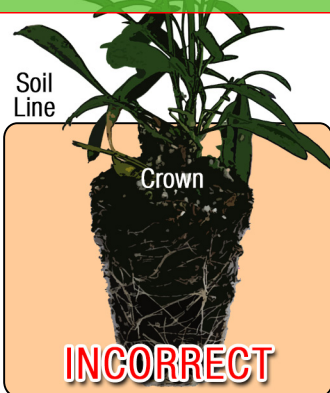
Habit: Shrubby

The first variegated Phygellus on the market! Lemon yellow leaves are dotted and splashed with bits of lime and pine green. Sometimes they are accented with a dollop of cream. This plant is so pretty, it doesn't need to flower, but when it does, it really all comes together! Coral orange trumpets call out to hummingbirds and bees. The excellent vigor of this plant will make it a super container, garden and border plant.
